On Tuesday, April 13th, all juniors and any senior who did not take the SAT in October, will participate in the SAT School Day administration.

Things to note:

- All tests will be paid for by the school district.
- The essay portion of the exam has been eliminated and schools do not have the option to give the essay.
- Breakfast will be provided from 7:30- 7:55 am under the new shelter located in the parking lot.
- Boxed lunches will be provided to students who place an order on the morning of testing with their testing proctor. Students should pick up lunches in the AP Room at the conclusion of testing.
- Normal bus routes will run on this day. Any student who is remote and plans to ride the bus on testing day
 will need to contact the main office no later than Friday, April 9th at 3pm, (309) 734-5118 to request a
 pick-up.
- Students should be in their testing rooms no later than 8:00 am. Testing *should* conclude around 12:30pm and students will be released for the day. Alternate arrangements for anyone riding a bus should be made in the event that testing lasts longer than expected.
- All electronic devices should be left at home or in a vehicle. Cell phones, smart watches, etc. will not be permitted in the testing room.

Things to bring:

- Signed self-certification form. Please find enclosed, if needed.
- Chromebook/charger if receiving MP3 Audio accommodations.
- Face covering
- Water bottle
- #2 pencils, sharpened with erasers
- Approved calculator (https://collegereadiness.collegeboard.org/sat/taking-the-test/calculator-policy)

Students will not be permitted in the building if they are not testing. Due to the need for all staff to be involved in testing in some capacity, classes will not be held (virtually or in-person) on this day.

Freshmen, sophomores, and any senior who already took the SAT will not be required to be in attendance on Tuesday, April 13th. These students will be asked to use this day to complete one of the following:

- Catch up day- work on homework, missing assignments, etc.
- College visit- set up a campus tour virtually or in-person
- Volunteer- donate your time to something you are passionate about
