This letter is to inform you of the events taking place on Wednesday, April 10th regarding the digital administration of spring standardized testing for all freshmen, sophomores, and juniors.

The PSAT reports scores on the same scale used by the SAT. Therefore, the PSAT serves as a practice for the SAT and allows students to develop a better understanding of how they may score on the SAT during their junior year. Students will be dismissed for the day at the conclusion of testing. Students receiving time and one half accommodations will require a 2nd day of testing on April 11th.

The following tests will be administered for each grade level:

Freshmen- PSAT 8/9 Sophomores- PSAT 10

Juniors- SAT with Essay (Illinois Graduation Requirement)

## Things to note:

- All tests will be paid for by the school district.
- A light breakfast will be provided from 7:55- 8:05 a.m.
- Students will be able to order school lunch, if needed.
- Students should report to their testing rooms no later than 8:10 a.m. Testing should conclude around 12:00 p.m.
- Normal bus routes will run on this day. Please make alternate arrangements if you do not plan to ride the bus.
- All electronic devices should be left at home or in a vehicle. Cell phones, smart watches, etc. will not be permitted in testing rooms.

## Things to bring:

- Charged chromebook and charger
- Approved calculator (https://collegereadiness.collegeboard.org/sat/taking-the-test/calculator-policy)

On this day, senior students will not report to school. Students will be asked to complete an activity in lieu of attending classes. Students should pick up a form from the counseling office and submit it to the main office no later than April 11th. The completed form will satisfy the attendance requirement for April 10th.
